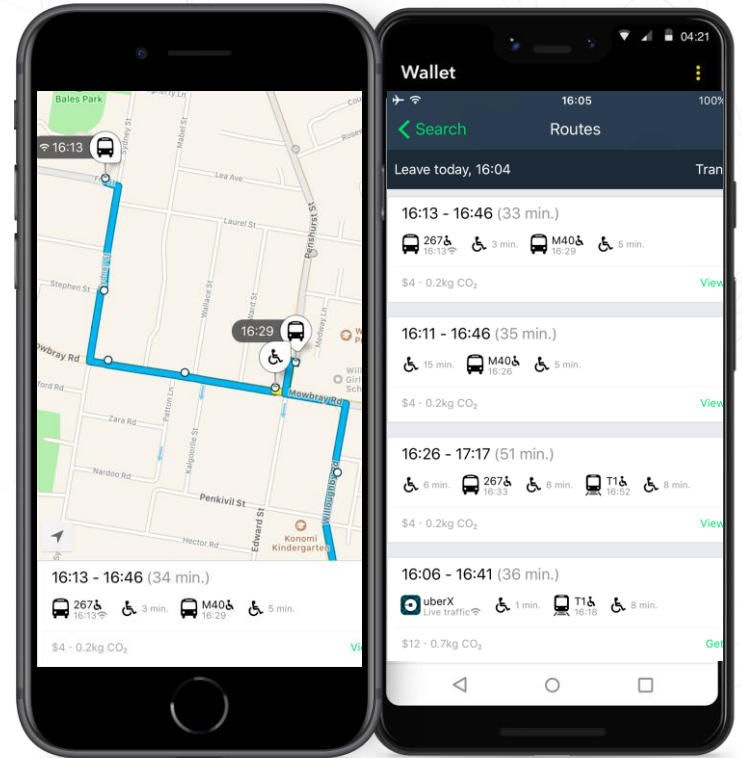

TripGo uses open data to provide wheelchair-friendly routing and real-time alerts

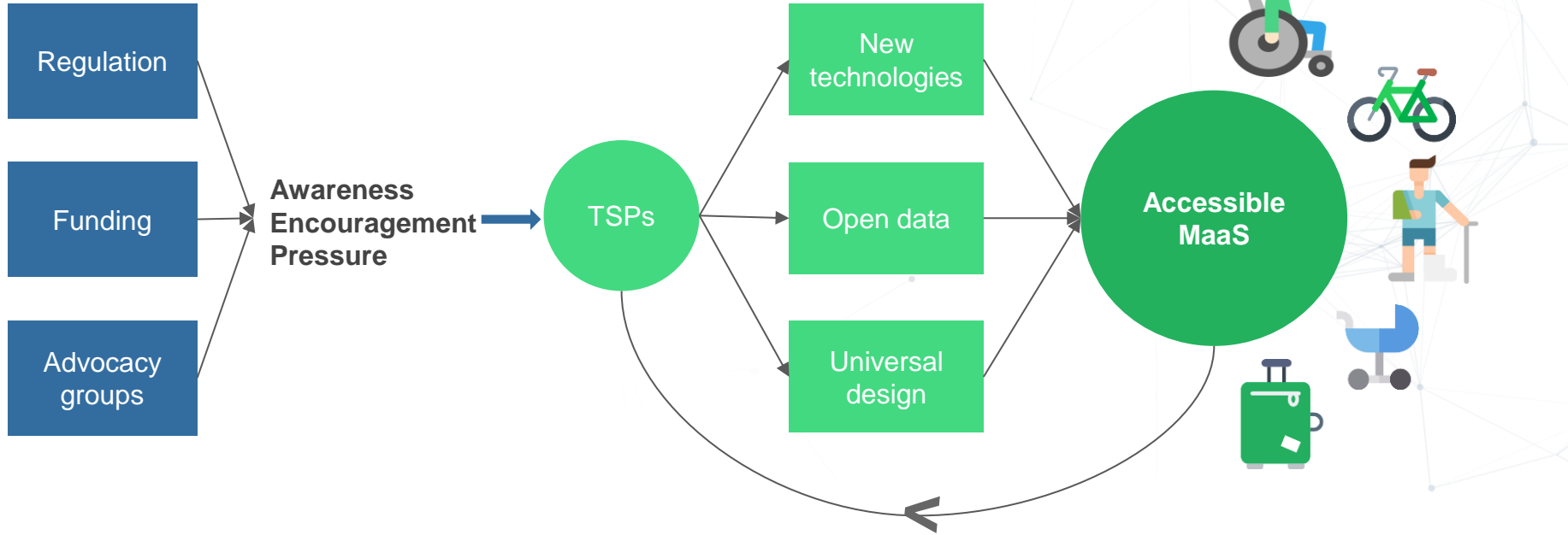
